Date: September 30, 2023, 7:00 - 10:00pm



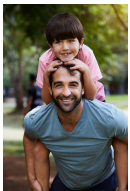

BOX TOPS FOR EDUCATION

The PTO is looking for your help with increasing our **Box Top participation!**

Since the physical box tops have been phased out, it's so easy to forget to scan receipts to earn money for our school.

Twice a year, our school receives a check to help pay for whatever we need - equipment, supplies or experiences the kids love!

To save free cash from being thrown out with the trash, **please send in your receipts with your students in their backpack**, and a volunteer will happily scan them for school credit!

There will be a zipper pouch outside of each classroom for your child to place receipts in, and a volunteer will collect them at the end of the week and scan them in, so you don't have to!

EC Parents - Do This Now!

Below are the things to take care of before you forget!

1) Order your student's hot Lunch (& volunteer to serve 1 lunch)

We are taking both **Chick-fil-A Tuesdays & Pizza Thursdays orders right now!** This is for **Sept - Dec** and you'll have a chance to order again for Jan - June later on. This is a ongoing PTO fundraiser (and a service to parents who don't like to pack lunch everyday like many of us).

To start serving right way, the deadline to submit your order is Friday, September 1, 2023! Please make your full payment when you register but we also understand there may be budgetary concerns so there's an option to break up your payments.

2) Register on our PTO website and social media accounts

We made it super easy to do with QR codes on the Get Connected page!

3) Sign up for your child(rens) Monthly Staff Appreciation by grade

We made it super easy again with details on which grades have which months. Go to the PTO website to sign up. (Sign up to volunteer for other things while on there too!)

8th grade starts first for October and it goes down each grade per month except the ones that PTO takes care of. You're bringing in items such as seltzer, fruit, chips, etc. to bless & stock the staff lounge with goodies. Love to bake? That's even better!
