Timeline

1:45 PM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Bus loop closed to vehicles
2:30 PM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Designated parents agreed upon by room parent and classroom teacher, may arrive to prepare classroom for parties. - As appropriate and needed, parents may arrive to help their child get dressed for the parade.
2:50 PM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Announcement for all parents and guests to exit the building and clear the parade route. - Parade observers should be in designated viewing areas and may not stand on or block sidewalks of the parade route. Kindly refrain from interrupting the line to ensure a continuous parade.
2:55 PM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Parade begins. Students in our autism classes will lead the parade, followed by grade levels in order, with fifth grade being the last group of students. All students exit from the APR hallway doors and re-enter the building at grade level designated doors.
Last student returns to their classroom	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Classroom party begins at the conclusion of the parade, when all students are safely back in their classroom. - Parade observers enter the building at the main office entrance.

Students who are not participating in the parade are welcome to come to the media center during that time. Mrs. Kelly and Ms. Cross will provide board games and table activities, as well as plenty of reading material. When the parade is over, students will have the choice of returning to their classrooms for the parties, or remaining in the media center until dismissal.
